<u>Contrai</u>	ndications for ALL Procedures – Please be aware if anything below applies, practitioners will not be able to safely complete your procedure.
	Are you under the age of 18? House of Beauty does not operate on minors
	Are you currently under a doctor's care for any condition?
	Do you require any pre-medication for any procedures?
	Pregnant or Nursing
	Chemotherapy or Radiation full treatments: Prophylactic chemotherapy is generally safe to proceed
	Any active rashes, breakouts, open sores or fever blisters anywhere on your face?
	Active case of rosacea, eczema, psoriasis, shingles or any skin condition.
	Sick with flu/fever.
	Waiting Periods
✓	Please remember permanent makeup is a process. It takes 6-8 weeks to heal between applications. Be patient while healing.
	Botox or Disport – 1 Day since you can't lie flat for at least 5 hours
	Fillers (i.e. Juvaderm, Silk, Voluma, Sculptra, etc.) – 1 week
	Accutane full dose – 1 year waiting period (half-dose or prophylactic dose just needs medical clearance)
	Topical Acne Cream – Benzoyl Peroxide, Clindamycin, Pro-Active – 1 week
	Suntanned skin – 3-4 weeks for your face and 2-3 months for scar camouflage
	Peels: Retinols, glycolic acid (A.H.A) and Vitamin C – 2-3 weeks
	Laser resurfacing – 8 weeks
	IPL (Intense Pulsed Light) – 2-weeks post
	Laser used to remove old permanent makeup – 8 weeks : Specific:
<u> </u>	Eyelash extensions must be removed 1-2 days prior to eyeliner
\checkmark	Contact Lenses must be removed prior to an eyeliner procedure (bring your glasses with you)
	Lasik - Cataract Surgery – 1 month prior and wait <i>3 months post-op</i>
	Sty or Chalazion – wait 2 wks. from time of healing
	Latisse or any other eyelash enhancement products (including mascaras) ~ minimum 2 weeks off o (Causes excessive bleeding, sensitivity, bruising and color may not be retained).
	Eye Diseases (i.e. Glaucoma or Graves' Disease: Hyper Thyroid) – require medical clearance
	Blepharitis: CONTAGIOUS – requires medical clearance – chronic inflammation of the eyelid, usually at base of lashes. Symptoms include inflammation, irritation, itchiness.
<u>Lip Spec</u>	
	Fillers (i.e. Juvaderm, Silk, Voluma, Sculptra, etc.) – 1-week minimum waiting period
	Fat transfer in lips – 1-month waiting period for swelling to subside
	Fever blisters on your face or lips. If you have EVER had even 1 in your lifetime, you will require an antivirus (valacyclovir) prescription from your family doctor to start as prescribed. Request enough medication for your touch-up visit to avoid 2-co-pays.
These N	Nedical Issues All Require Written Medical Clearance/Possible Pre-Medication for These Procedures
	Heart valves, all stents, titanium rods, screws, pacemakers, rheumatic fever – medical clearance and pre-medication
	Organ transplants – medical clearance and pre-medication
	Joint replacements – medical clearance and pre-medication
	Insulin dependent diabetics – medical clearance and pre-medication
	Fever blister history – pre-medication as prescribed or minimum 2-days prior and 4-days post
	Shingles history: only if outbreak occurred within 1 year – medical clearance and pre-medication
	Seizures – medical clearance
	Blood thinners – medical clearance
	Long term steroids – medical clearance
	Lupus/ Autoimmune Disease – medical clearance and pre-medication
